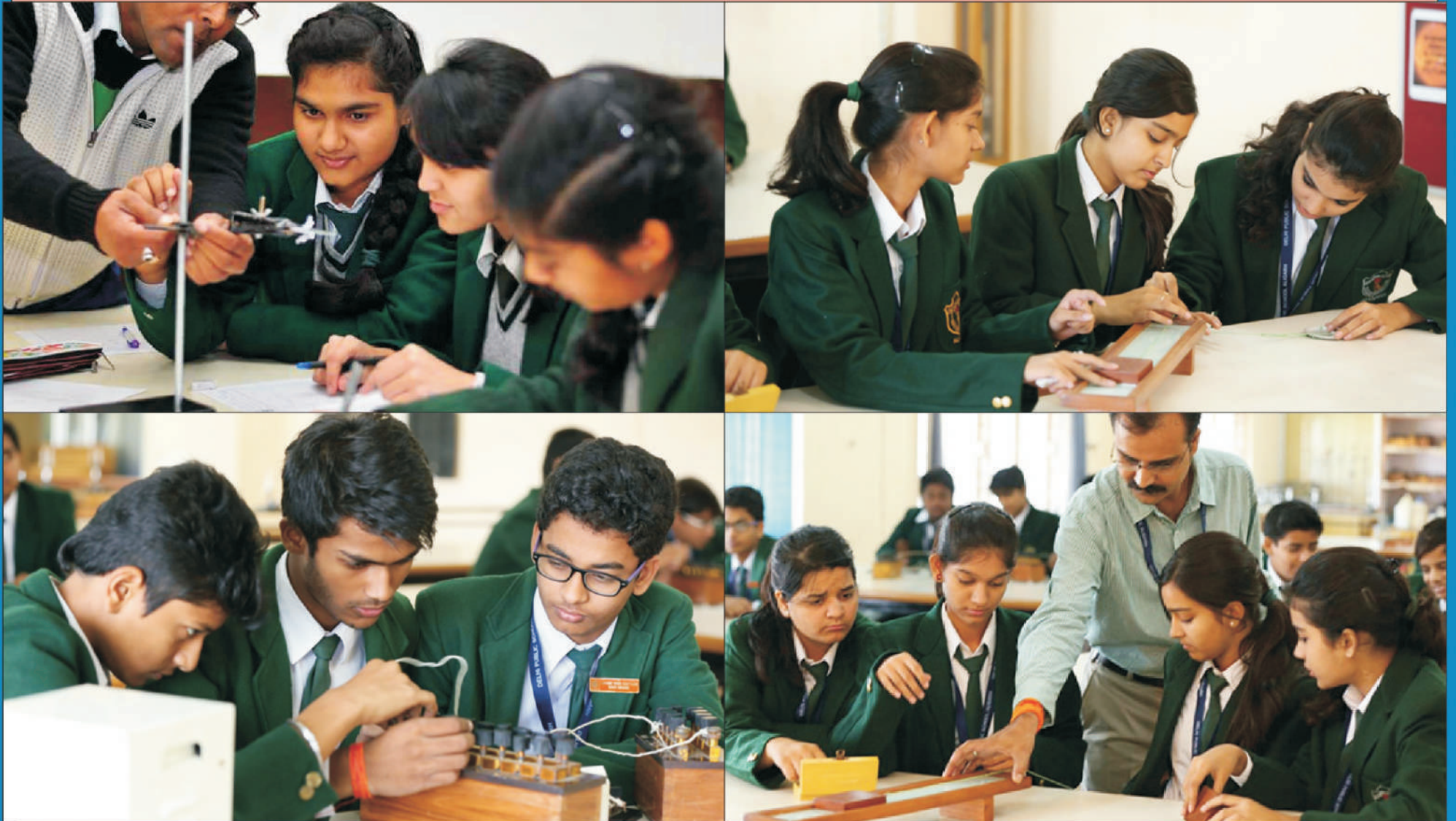
Religious and moral education

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Session: 1st April to 31st March.

Admission starts from 16th of January for new session in each year

Eligibility

Children seeking admission in Play Group should be minimum 3 years old but should not be more than 4 years.

Registration

- Prospectus and registration form for admission can be obtained from the school office on all working days.
- It should be duly filled and submitted with required documents and Age proof certificate as mentioned in the form. Age proof certificate and ID proof of their parents must be submitted along with form.
- The registered candidates will be called for admission test/interview.
- Registration fee is not refundable and registration is no guarantee for admission.
- Admission test will be conducted at an interval of every 15 days.
- Declaration of admission test result will be done on the same day and all admission formalities has to be completed by next working day. If the candidate fail to complete the admission formalities on the said day has to go again under the new procedure of admission test by new admission form.

Test/Interviwe

1. Admission will be made strictly on the basis of merit.
2. Admission is on the basis of written test and interview
Minor interview of parents will also be conducted.
3. For Admission to different higher class test conducted standard wise
4. For admission to higher classes, written as well as oral tests are conducted accordingly.
5. There is no written test for admission in Pre-Primary (PG- UKG) and class I and II. However, children seeking admission are required to appear for grip and oral test accompanied by their parents.



4. Categories of students shall not remain in the class
 - (a) Those who fail to show satisfactory progress and are unwilling or unable to benefit from the educational programmes.
 - (b) Those whose fees are in continuous dues status
 - (c) Those whose behavior in the opinion of the principal is harmful in the interest of the school.
 - (d) Those who fails in their class or below average (students above class 5th.
5. Withdrawals or transfer is not possible in March.
6. The transfer certificate, the school transfer certificate or the Progress Report shall not be issued until all the dues are paid.

Personal File:

The school will maintain an individual file for its children to have a systematic record for the academic achievement, fee as well as co-curricular activities (CCA) progress.

IDENTITY CARD:

An identity card bearing a passport size photograph, transport facility and address of the student will remain in his/her custody all the time.

LEAVE RULE:

- If a student remains absent from the class without information, continuously for more than 7 days, or with fees dues for more than 3 months, his/her name may be struck-off from the enrolment register and is subjected to re-admission.
- Leave application must be sent / duly signed by the parents and a note must be made in student's diary. Students are expected to be present at school on the opening and closing day after and before long vacation.
- Absence due to sickness must be supported by a medical certificate. The student attending school after suffering from an infectious disease such as Measles, Chicken pox, Cholera, Mumps, Whooping Cough etc.
- The opinion of the doctor is respected in case of sickness.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The school follows the newly amended pattern of studies and examination system by the C.B.S.E. New Delhi

- Students of classes 6 to 8 will now follow a uniform assessment scheme with a two-semester system that will include half yearly and annual examinations.
- The assessment, examination and report card patterns for class 9 students will be similar to that of class 10 Board students.
- Every semester, two 10-mark tests or periodic assessments will be conducted for classes 6 to 8. The half yearly written examination will carry 80 marks.
- The NCERT syllabus needs to be followed by schools in the upper primary classes.
- Students of classes 6 to 8 will need to study mathematics, science and social science, along with three languages and one other subject.
- In classes 6 to 8, the annual exams will be based on the syllabus of the second half of the year, along with a certain percentage of the half yearly syllabus. For class 6, 10 per cent of the half yearly syllabus will be included in the annuals, while for classes 7 and 8, the percentage of half yearly syllabus to be included in the final examination is 20 per cent and 30 per cent respectively.
- Grading will be carried out separately for scholastic (academic) and non-scholastic (co-curricular) activities.
- Students of classes 6 to 8 will be graded on a three-point scale in the non-scholastic activities of Work Education, Art Education, and Health and Physical Education. The factors on which they will be graded are regularity, participation, output and teamwork. Students will also receive marks for submission of notebooks.
- In Secondary and Senior secondary level, assessment is subject to change according to CBSE guidelines.**

PROMOTION RULE:

1. There is no detention policy in Primary Section.
2. If a student fails in more than two main subjects(VI-VIII) and fail in one main subject (Class IX onward) can't be promoted to next class without clearing Re-exam. It's a must to score a minimum of 33% in each subject to pass.
3. A minimum of 75% of attendance is required to appear in Session-Ending examination.

PROMOTION TO HIGHER CLASS

- (i) Every student is required to get a qualified grade D or above in all the subjects excluding 6th additional subject as per scheme of study for the purpose of promotion to next class.
- (ii) A student getting E1 or E2 in scholastic area in one or more subjects will have to improve his/her performance in one subsequent attempt to obtain qualify Grade D in these subjects
- (iii) If a student fail to obtain qualifying Grade D in one or more subjects, even after adding grade! points from Co-scholastic areas and after available one improvement chance, he/she will be required to request the same during next academic year.
- (iv) It is mandatory required to appear in both summative assessment during the academic year.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

A duplicate copy of the certificate may be issued only on producing a copy of the FIR the lost original certificate on a cash payment of Rs.450/-

HOUSE SYSTEM

Inter-house competition are held time to time to inculcate the qualities of leadership, healthy if competition and team spirit in the students. The houses are named after great religious and national leaders/ legendary freedom fighters.



INSTRUCTION OF THE PAYMENT OF FEE

1. Fee-timing will be 9am to 1 pm at Cambridge International school Campus.
2. Last date for acceptance of school fee is 15th of the month.
3. A late fine of Rs 50/- will be charged, if tuition fee cleared in the next month.
4. Possibility of deposit school fee through Bank is being considered seriously.
5. The name of the defaulter will be struck off from the attendance register after non-payment of the fee for two months without any further information to the concern.
6. Re-admission may be accepted on payment of admission fee of Rs. 300 with the permission of the Manager/Principal.
7. Advance Fee on yearly basis is also accepted but if the fee is deposited in advance of complete session, a discount of six percent will be given to the respective student.
8. For the class 10th the school fee, till March, has to be deposited by January. So as to get no dues certificate.

GUIDELINE FOR STUDENTS

- Any damage to the school property by the student will be borne by the student's guardians.
- Students should be regular in attendance/classes.
- School identity Card must be with the students on all working days.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours.
- Students must come in school uniform.
- They must be clean, neat, and tidy.
- Application for leave must be submitted a day in advance. It should be countersigned by the parents/guardians.
- The school bus user must strictly observe the rules of the school transport.
- All the students must possess school diary, text book, notebook, Stationery etc.

- Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to the school, the school will not be responsible for any such loss.
- The school reserves the right to take stern action even to strike off the students from the school rolls who are guilty of misconduct.
- They should keep their bicycle locked. They should not ride them in the school campus.
- The student should arrive at the school at least 15 minutes prior to the bell rings for the assembly.

GUIDELINE FOR PARENTS

Please: Parents are required to submit their ID proof in the school office at the time of the admission done.

- Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher/Co-ordinator and the diary should be checked daily for home work & teacher's remark.
- All the parents are required to complete all the text books, items of stationary, craft, materials etc, right from the beginning of the session.
- Ensure that all the books and note books are covered with brown paper.
- Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform, with polished shoes, trimmed hair and clean nails.
- Send the children regularly and punctually to school. No absence will be permitted without a leave application and late comers will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- The parents must attend the parents-teachers meet.
- Pay the fee as per schedule.
- Intimate the school in case of change of address, telephone number etc.
- Do not send the child to school in case of infection disease, and a medical certificate should be furnished from a medical reason at the time of rejoining the school after illness.
- Do not walk into the class room to meet the teacher in the class-room and do not interview any teacher without the permission of the Director/Principal.
- Do not visit the teachers at their residence.
- Do not send money or valuable articles with the students. The school takes no responsibility in case they are lost.
- Send application in case of any change in address or any kind of Live.
- It is compulsory for your ward to appear in all the Formative assessments.



CURRICULUM

The school curriculum and books from nursery to VIII are designed on the basis of NCERT syllabus and guidelines.

For secondary of Sr. Secondary level we follow the syllabi prescribed by CBSE, New Delhi. The medium of instruction is English. A candidate may opt for one of the following groups in Sr. Secondary classes.

LIBRARY RULES

- Silence is to be observed in library. Book issued are to be properly looked after and returned on the due date failing which Rs. 50 per day shall be charged.
- Making underline, cutting or erasing in the library is strictly prohibited.
- Reference: Books, current magazines, periodicals, and books placed on the open shelves are to be read in the reading room only. These are not meant to be issued.

ATTENDANCE

1. It is compulsory to attend the school on the first day after any break or any festival. Attendance on working Saturday, particularly in Annual Day Celebration, Sports Day, Inter House or Inter School Competition is compulsory.
2. The minimum requirement of attendance during a session is 80%.
3. In case of illness, Medical Certificate should be attached with an application.
4. For long leave prior permission is needed.

PARENTS TEACHER MEETING

It is compulsory for the parent to attend Parents Teacher Meeting according to the schedule, given in the almanac. The parents will come to school as per the time allotted to them by the teacher.

PARENTS' CO-OPERATION

It is the responsibility of the parents to see that

- The ward maintains punctuality and regularity in the school.
- CDs/Cassettes provided by the school should be used regularly at home too.
- All dues should be paid in time.
- Special care should be taken and no damage should be done to the school property.
- Only prescribed books are allowed in the school.
- Books and note books should always be maintained in good condition.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The school lays great emphasis on physical fitness of students and tries to provide facilities games, sports and recreational activities for all. The program includes rhythmic exercise, gymnastics, drills and sports like hockey, football, cricket, volleyball, badminton, lawn tennis, kho-kho and table tennis.

The occasion is to be availed for building up mutual understanding between parents and teachers with regard to the all round progress of their ward. Criticism of teachers or the school in the presence of the students must be avoided.

The parents/Guardians are requested to sign the monthly and terminal reports and take active interest in the activities and function of the school.

SCHOOL CURRICULUM

SCHEME OF WORK



The entire curriculum of the school has been planned to fulfill the overall needs of the students as per the C.B.S.E. Guidelines each Subject is tested and marked to check the thinking, understanding & logical skills. We also carefully nurture the emotional and social skills of students to improvise the leadership, attentiveness, application and investigatory skills.

ACADEMICS

Four sections: Pre-primary, Middle and senior have been formed to ensure effective and smooth functioning.

PRE-PRIMARY

(Play Group to I) The school adopts play way and Montessori methods to make teaching interesting and

effective. Stress is aid on language physical, cognitive, Social and Aesthetic development. Moral values are inculcated among the children English, Mathematics, Hindi, Environmental Studies computer are the subjects which are taught through play way method.

PRIMARY (II TO V)

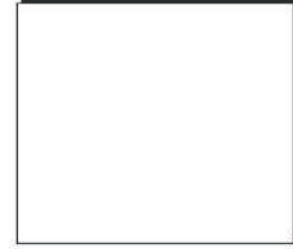
